PARTS OF SPECH










PARTS OF SPEECH

It refers to the role a word plays in a sentence.









NOUN

It refers to a word or phrase that represent a person, a place, a thing, an animal, a name.

Example: dog, cat, Andres, teacher, student, apple, etc.

The cat is small. Cat is the noun.









PRONOUN

A pronoun is used to replace a noun in order to avoid repetition.

Example: I, you, he, she, it, we, they, his, them, their, that, these.

Darwin is from Boyacá. He is tall. He is the pronoun.









ADJECTIVE

It describes or give more information about a noun or pronoun.

Example: Cold, happy, rich, poor, young, far, pink, blue.

I have a big house. Big is the adjective.









VERB

Actions that nouns do.

Example: Swim, run, eat, cook, sleep.

He swims fast. Swims is the verb.









ADVERB

It modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb. It tells how often, when, where.

Example: Slowly, quickly, always, really, badly.

She walks slowly. Slowly is the adverb.









PREPOSITION

It shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another Word.

Example: In, on, at, from, under, next to, between.

The book is on the table.

On is the preposition.









CONJUCTION

It joins two words, ideas, phrases together.

Example: But, and, while, when, or, because.

I like bananas and blueberries on my cereal.

And is the conjunction.









INTERJECTION

It is a Word that expresses a strong emotion. It is a short exclamation.

Example: Ouch!, hey!, oh!, wow!

Wow! I passed my English exam. Wow! Is the interjection.









They live in a beautiful house.

Ahh, that feels wonderful.

You are smart students.

She <u>accepted</u> the job offer.

You can have peach ice cream <u>or</u> a brownie sundae.
