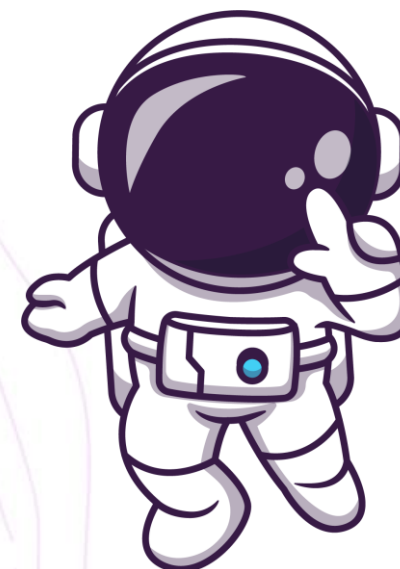

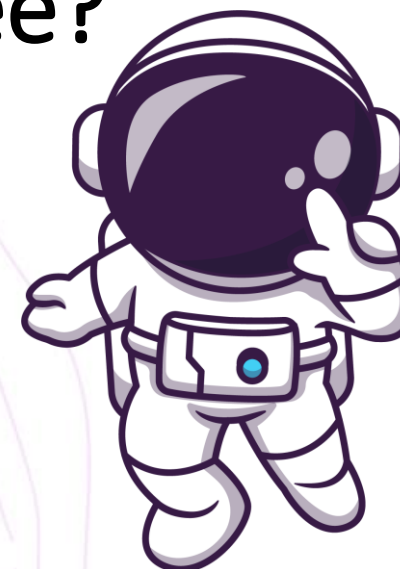

REMEMBER

COUNTABLE NOUNS

Have a singular and plural form

Can use a *singular* verb or
a *plural* verb

We can count

a tree two trees

The **book** is old.

The **books** are old.

UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

Have only one form (no plural)

Always use a singular verb

Cannot use *a*, *an* or *a number*
before them

We cannot count

butter butter~~s~~

Sugar is sweet.

~~a~~ rice ~~two~~ rice
~~a~~ bread ~~two~~ bread

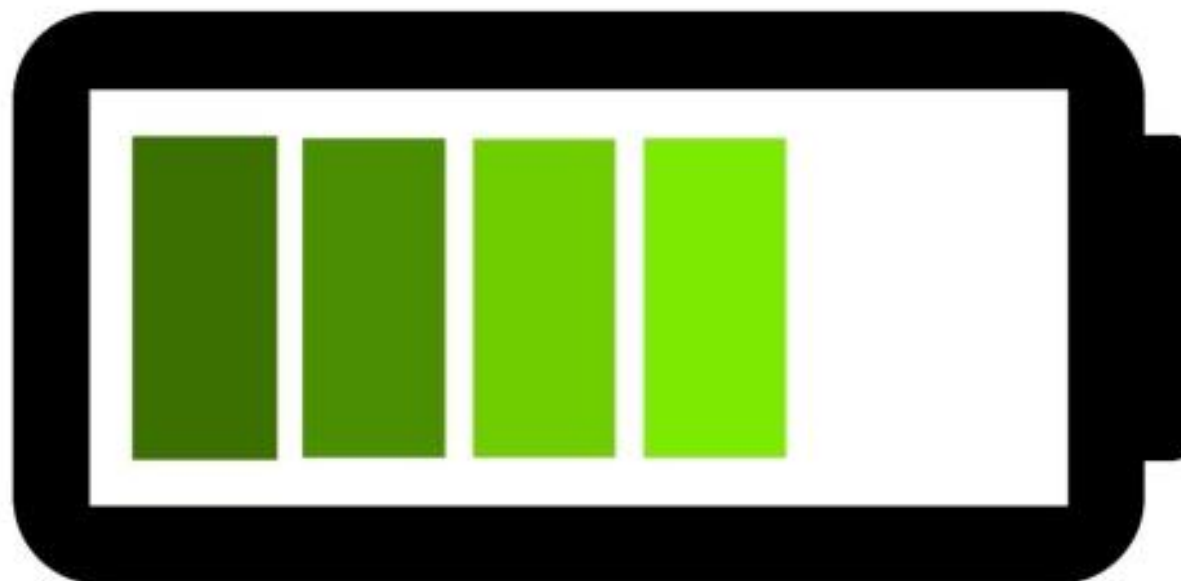


HOW MANY TABS ARE OPEN?





HOW MUCH BATTERY DO YOU HAVE?



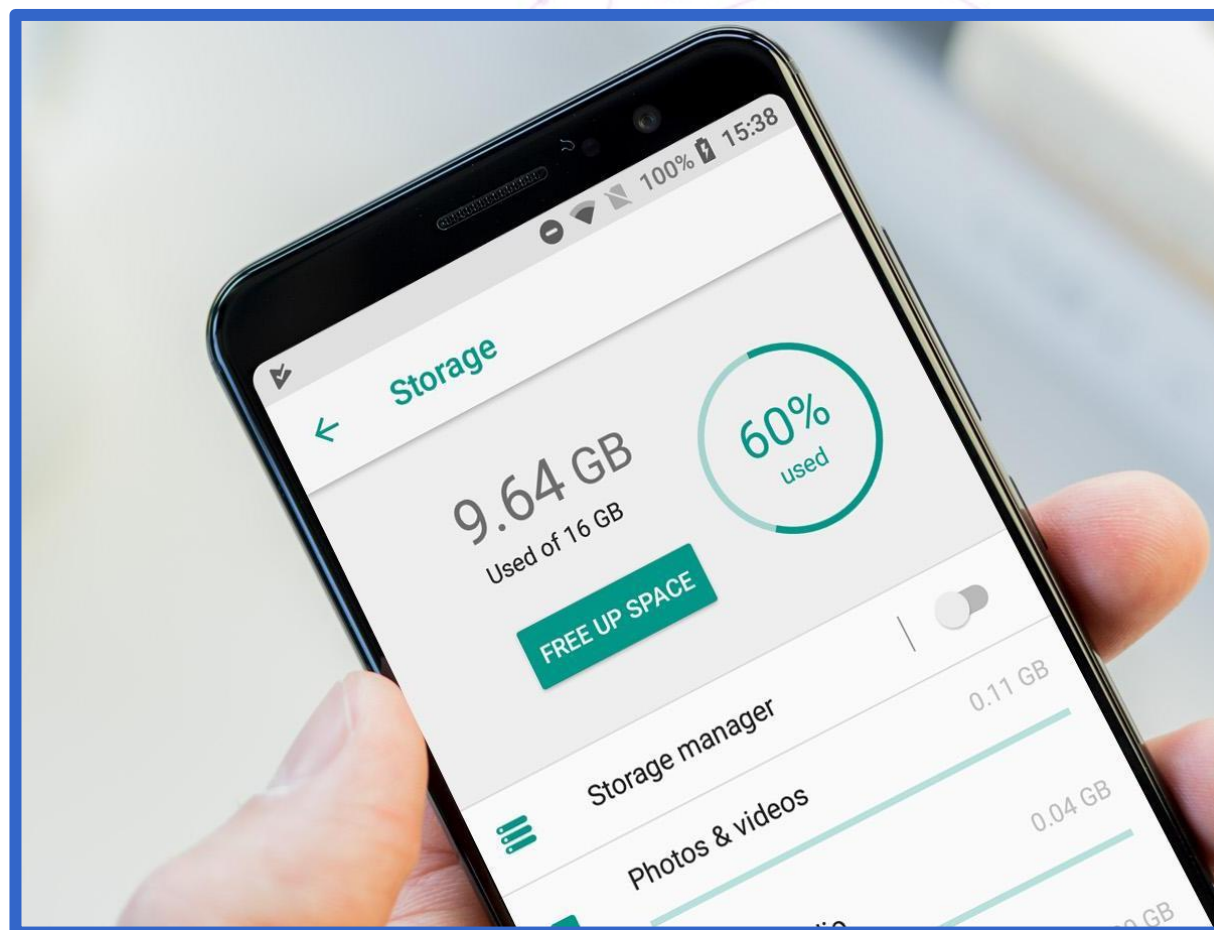


HOW MANY CAMERAS ARE THERE?





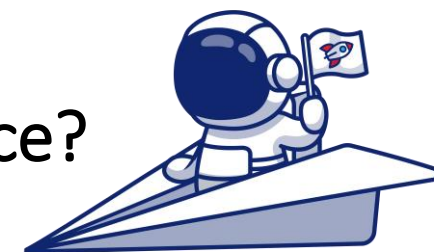
