# COMPARATIVES

Adjectives with **one** or two **syllable\***: add “er” “r” + than

Fast	Faster than	This laptop is faster than the laptops I have at the office.
Narrow	Narrower than	The roads in U.K are narrower than the roads in this city.
Old	Older than	Bill Gates is older than Elon Musk.
Large	Larger than	Avenues are larger than roads.
Nice	Nicer than	These webcams I just bought are nicer than the webcams I bought one year ago. <i>* Remember some of them follow this rules and others don't.</i>



# COMPARATIVES

Adjectives with two or more syllables: add “more” “less” + “than”

Peaceful	more peaceful than	Colombian mountains are more peaceful than in other countries.
Careful	more careful than	My sister is more careful than me.
Expensive	more expensive than	Apple smartphones are more expensive than Alcatel smartphones.
Intelligent	more intelligent than	Sofia the robot is more intelligent than a regular person.
Important	more important than	My tablet is more important than my mp3.



# COMPARATIVES

Adjectives with two syllables that end in “y” drop “y” and add “ier”

Happy	happier than	John looks happier than David
Angry	angrier than	Our teacher is angrier than the other teachers at school.
Busy	busier than	We are busier than before with all the work we have during pandemic.



# COMPARATIVES

**One-Syllable** adjective ending with a Single Consonant with a Single Vowel before it. **Double the last consonant** and add “er”

Big	Bigger than	Houses in Colombia are bigger than houses in Canada.
Thin	Thinner than	The hard disk in this desktop is thinner than the one in my laptop.
Hot	Hotter than	In our country June is hotter than October.

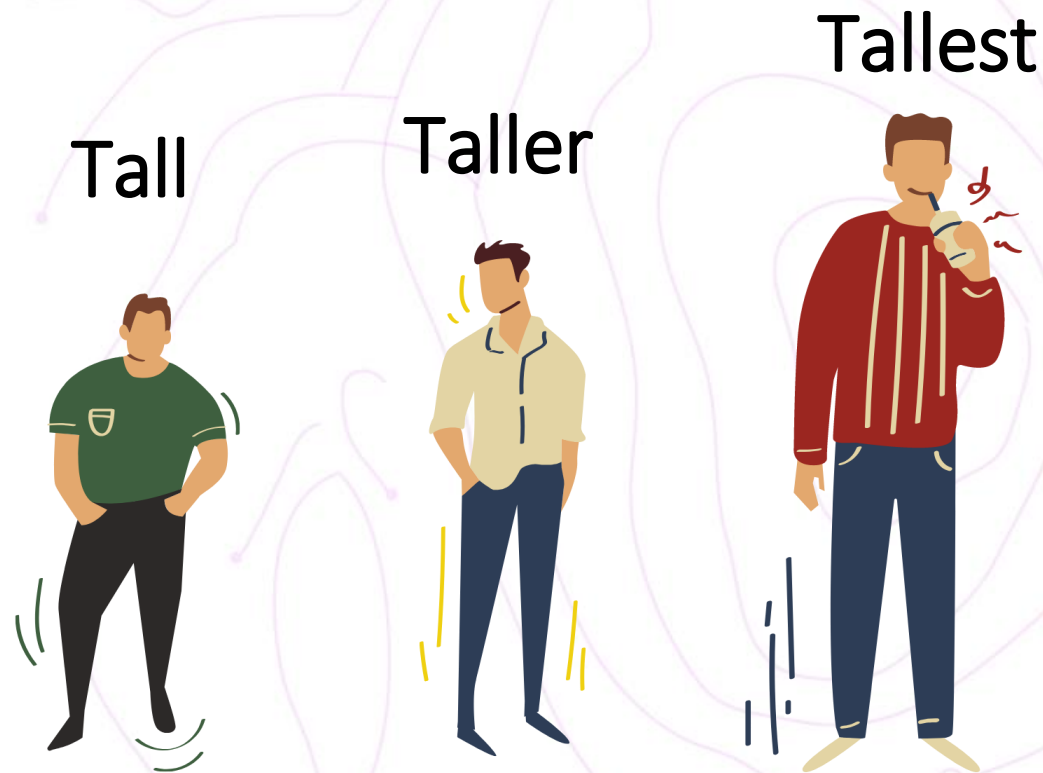

A superlative adjective expresses the extreme or highest degree of a quality. We use a superlative adjective to describe the extreme quality of one thing in a group of things.

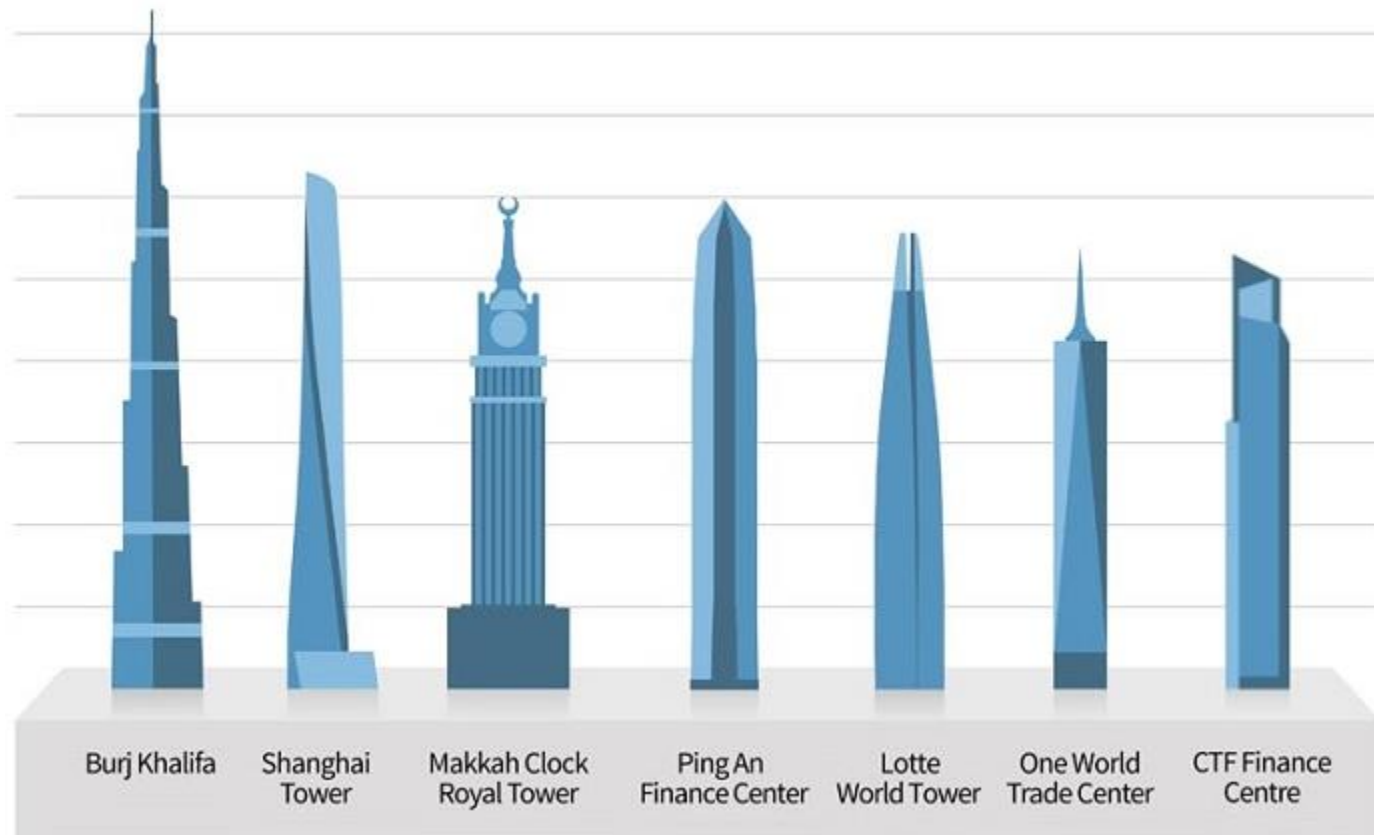
We use similar

comparatives.







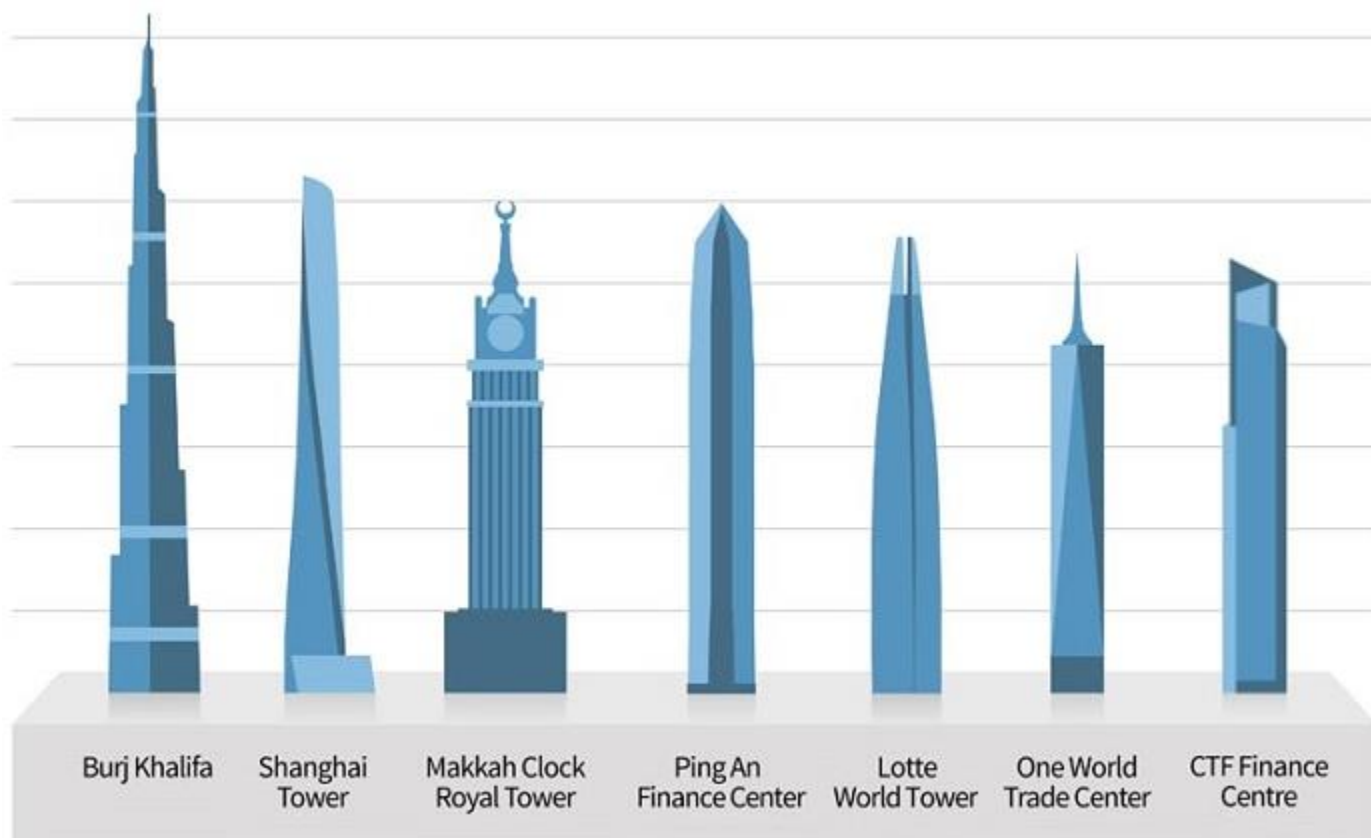

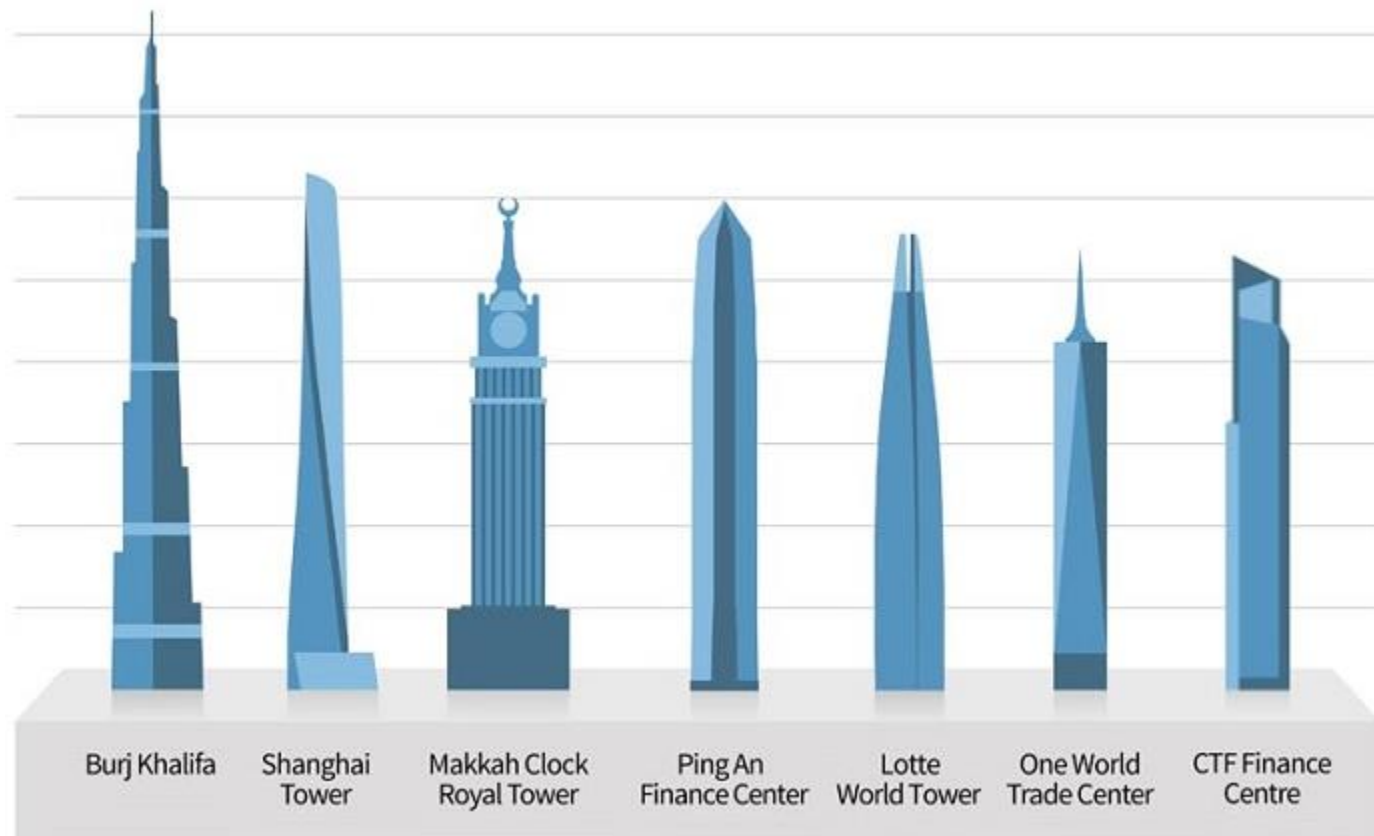

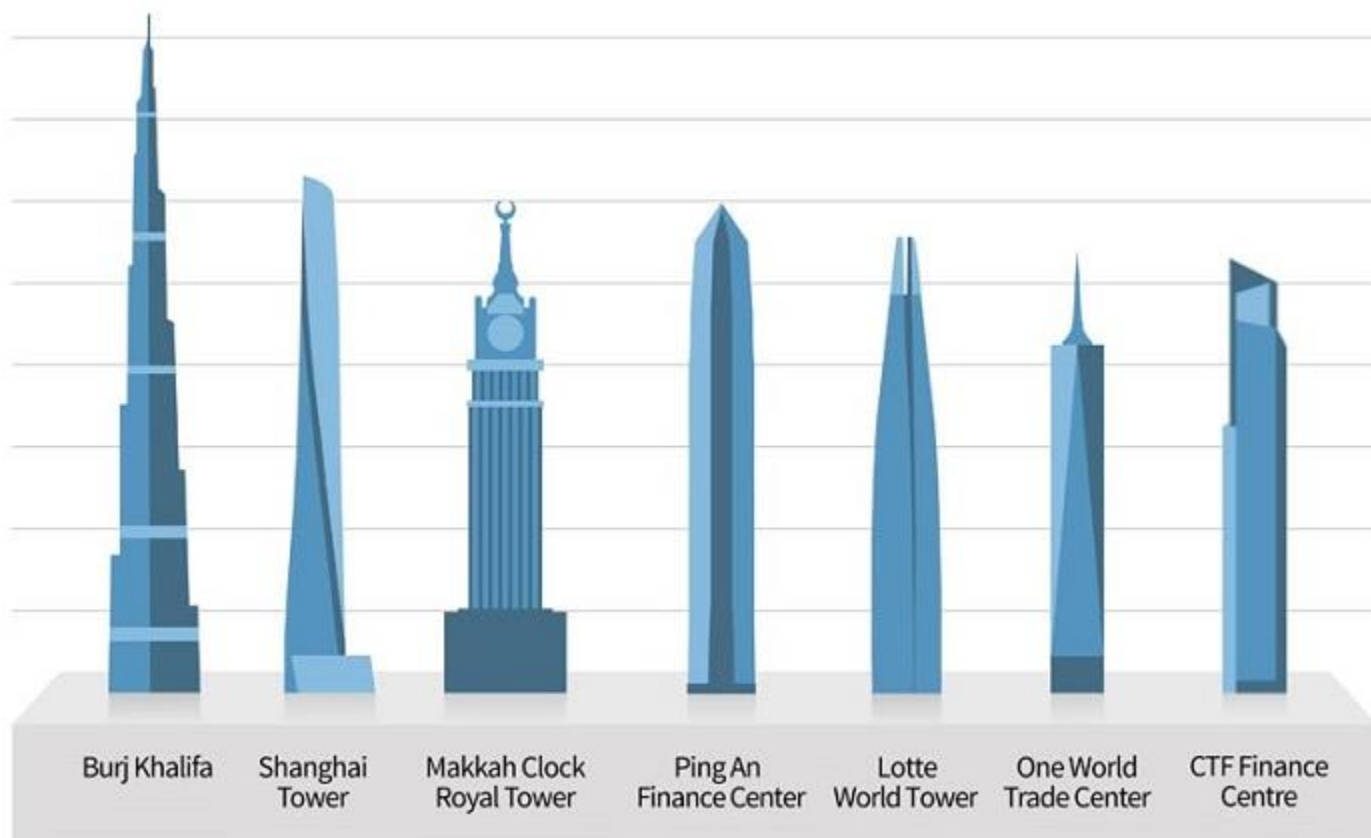

# SUPERLATIVES

Superlative adjectives	Form	Example
One syllable	The + adj + <b>est</b>	This is the oldest video camera in the world.
Two syllables ending in "y"	The + adj+ <b>iest</b>	The Wi-Fi connection at my faculty is the busiest in the whole campus.
Two syllables ending or more	The + most + adj	Home is the most peaceful place to be right now.
Adjectives ending by a single vowel with a consonant	The + adjective (double the last consonant + est	The computer was the biggest invention in the XX century.

Good	Better	The best
Bad	Worse	The worst
Far	Farther	The furthest
Little	Less	The least
Many	More	The most

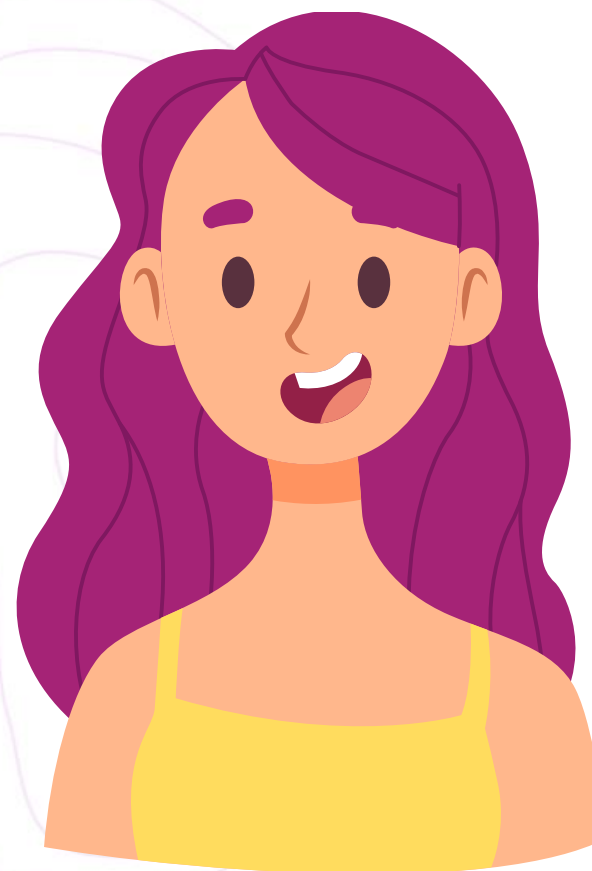
# WHAT ARE DISCOURSE MARKERS?

Discourse markers are ‘**words** (or **phrase**) tags’ that are used at the **beginning of sentences** (few times they can even be used in the middle) to help them seem clearer and more understandable. They **help join ideas** and act as a **connection or link** between sentences and paragraphs.



# DISCOURSE MARKERS

Remember there are other ways to say first of all: **in first place, to start with, firstly.**

# DISCOURSE MARKERS



Remember that to  
sequence your ideas you  
can use: **second, in second  
place, third, thirdly.**



# DISCOURSE MARKERS

**Finally,** I finish my  
own product and  
I'm ready to start  
my own company.





# DISCOURSE MARKERS



In conclusion you need to remember that for closing your ideas you can use **lastly, in conclusion or finally, etc.**
