

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



ING SPELLING RULES

- Most verbs just take –ing with no changes in spelling:
- watch-watching
- clean-cleaning
- listen-listening

Verbs with short vowels and one consonant, double the consonant:

- run-running
- swim-swimming

Verbs ending in – (e) drop it before –ing:

- live-living
- write-writing

Verbs ending in —ie change it to —y:

- lie-lying
- die-dying

tie-tying

Verbs ending in2 –I, double it:

- travel-travelling
- cancel-cancelling




