



Modal Verb	Expressing	Example
man of	Strong obligation	You must stop when the traffic lights turn red.
must	logical conclusion / Certainty	He must be very tired. He's been working all day long.
must not	prohibition	You must not smoke in the hospital.
	ability	I can swim.
can	permission	Can I use your phone, please?
	possibility	Smoking can cause cancer.









#### LET'S EXPLORE THEM

Modal Verb	Expressing	Example
	ability in the past	When I was younger I could run fast.
could	polite permission	Excuse me, could I just say something?
	possibility	It could rain tomorrow!
	permission	May I use your phone, please?
may	possibility, probability	It may rain tomorrow!
	polite permission	Might I suggest an idea?
might	possibility, probability	I might go on holiday to Australia next year.

Modal Verb	Expressing	Example
	50 % obligation	I should / ought to see a doctor. I have a terrible headache.
should/ought to	advice	You should / ought to revise your lessons
	logical conclusion	He should / ought to be very tired. He's been working all day long.
