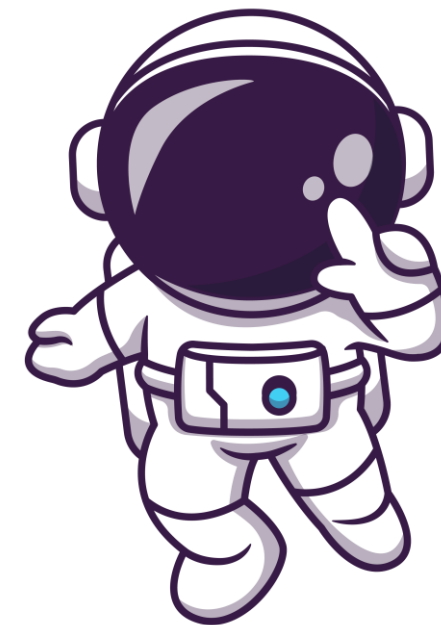


GERUNDS - ING (*SUBJECTS*)

I would like to design my first web application.

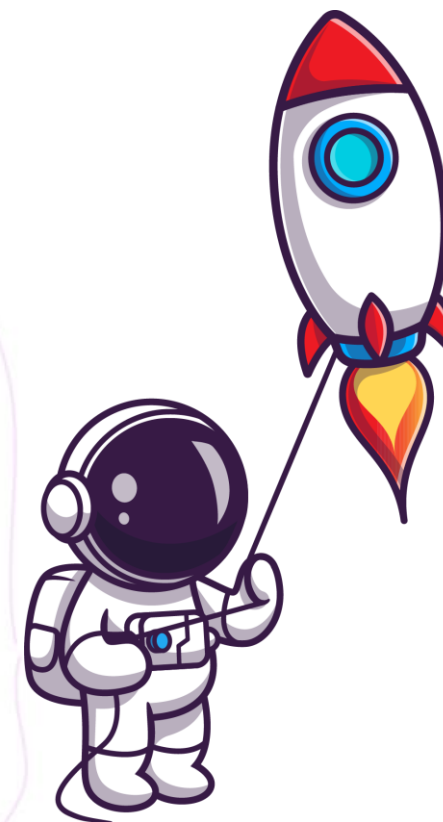
