




(PRESENT SIMPLE + PRESENT SIMPLE)

Scientific facts

Instructions

General truths

Natural laws

Daily routine/rules

- -They design websites every month.
- I don't like to turn on my computer at nights.
- Larissa fixes her computer sometimes.
- Antonella doesn't decrease volume using the device controls.











CONDITION

- If clause
- When clause

(PRESENT SIMPLE)



If it rains, When it rains,

RESULT

+ main clause

(PRESENT SIMPLE)



the mountain gets wet.













main clause

(present simple)



The mountain gets wet

CONDITION




- If clause

(present simple)



if it rains.when it rains.











Examples:

- If you heat ice, it melts.
- Ice melts if you heat it.
- If you mix red and yellow, you get orange.
- You get orange if you mix red and yellow.











Use of the imperative in the main clause.





If you travel abroad, remember your passport









Use of the imperative:

- If you go to the supermarket, bring some lentils.
- If you see Manuela, tell her she needs to do this activity.
- If my mother comes, call me.

FIRST CONDITIONAL TYPE 1










FIRST CONDITIONAL

Predicting a likely result





- Maritza won't sign up for that social network.












FIRST CONDITIONAL

CONDITION



(present simple)



If you study,

RESULT



(Future simple= will or won't)



you will improve your English skills.











FIRST CONDITIONAL

Examples:

- If I have enough money, I will buy an enormous house.
- I will buy an enormous house if I have enough money.
- Michael will be late if the bus is delayed.
- If the bus is delayed, Michael will be late.
