The prepositions of place **AT**, **IN** and **ON** refer to a place where something or someone is located.

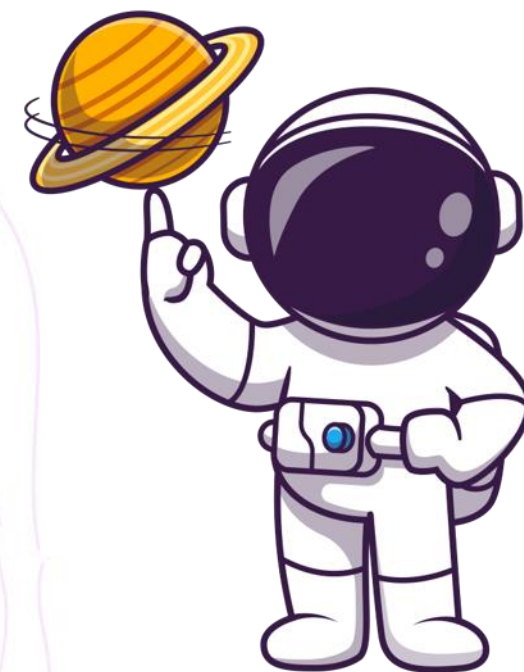
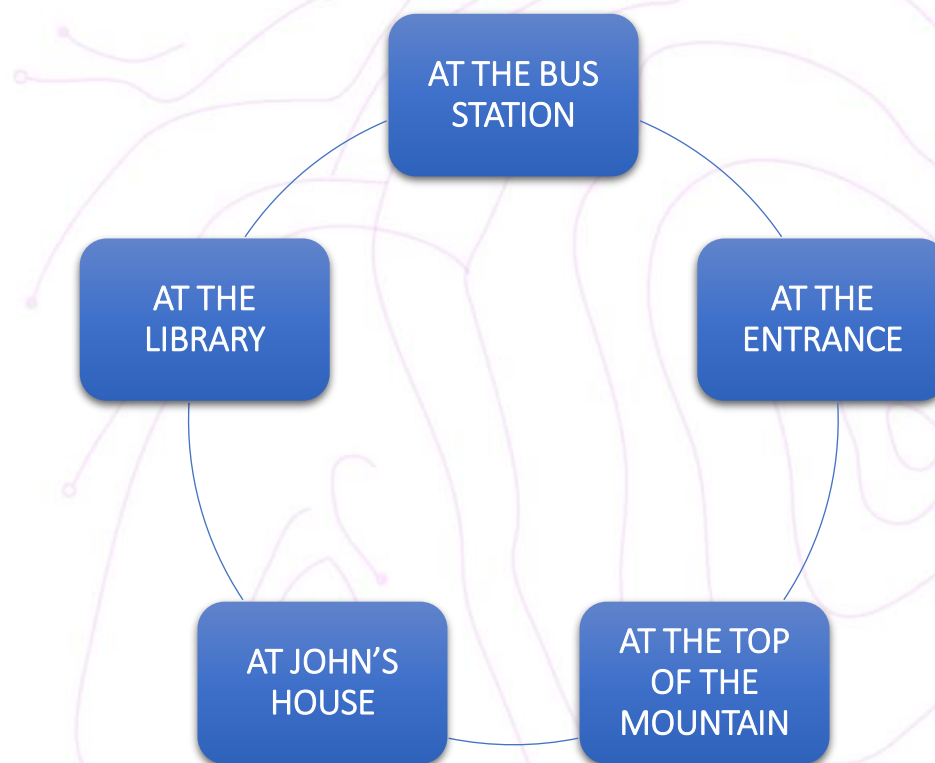




AT

is used to locate something at a certain point.

It is the most specific of
the three prepositions to
indicate a specific place.





EXAMPLE

We were waiting **at the bus station** when it started to rain.

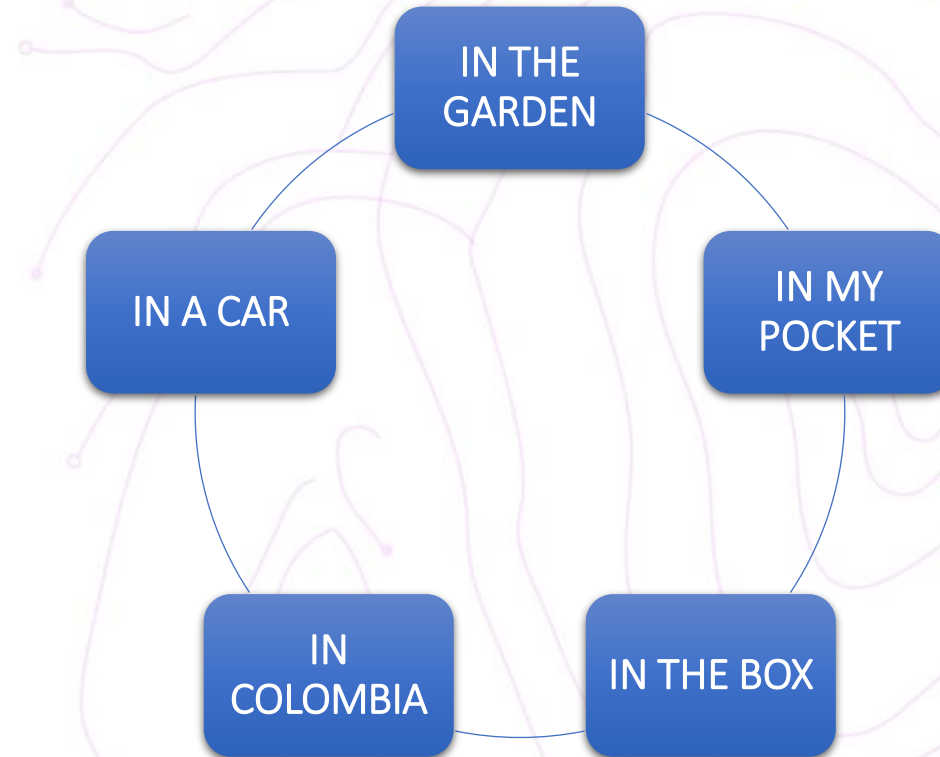
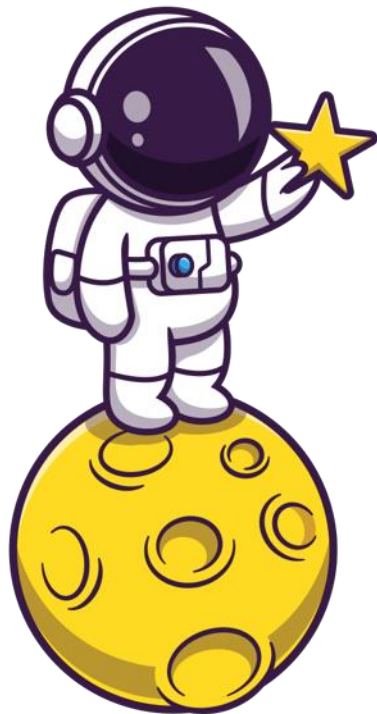
He was **at the entrance** of the theater when he heard the noise.

IN

is used to locate something enclosed in a space



ENCLOSED
SPACES



EXAMPLE

Do you live **in Japan**?

The best food can be found **in the center** of the city.

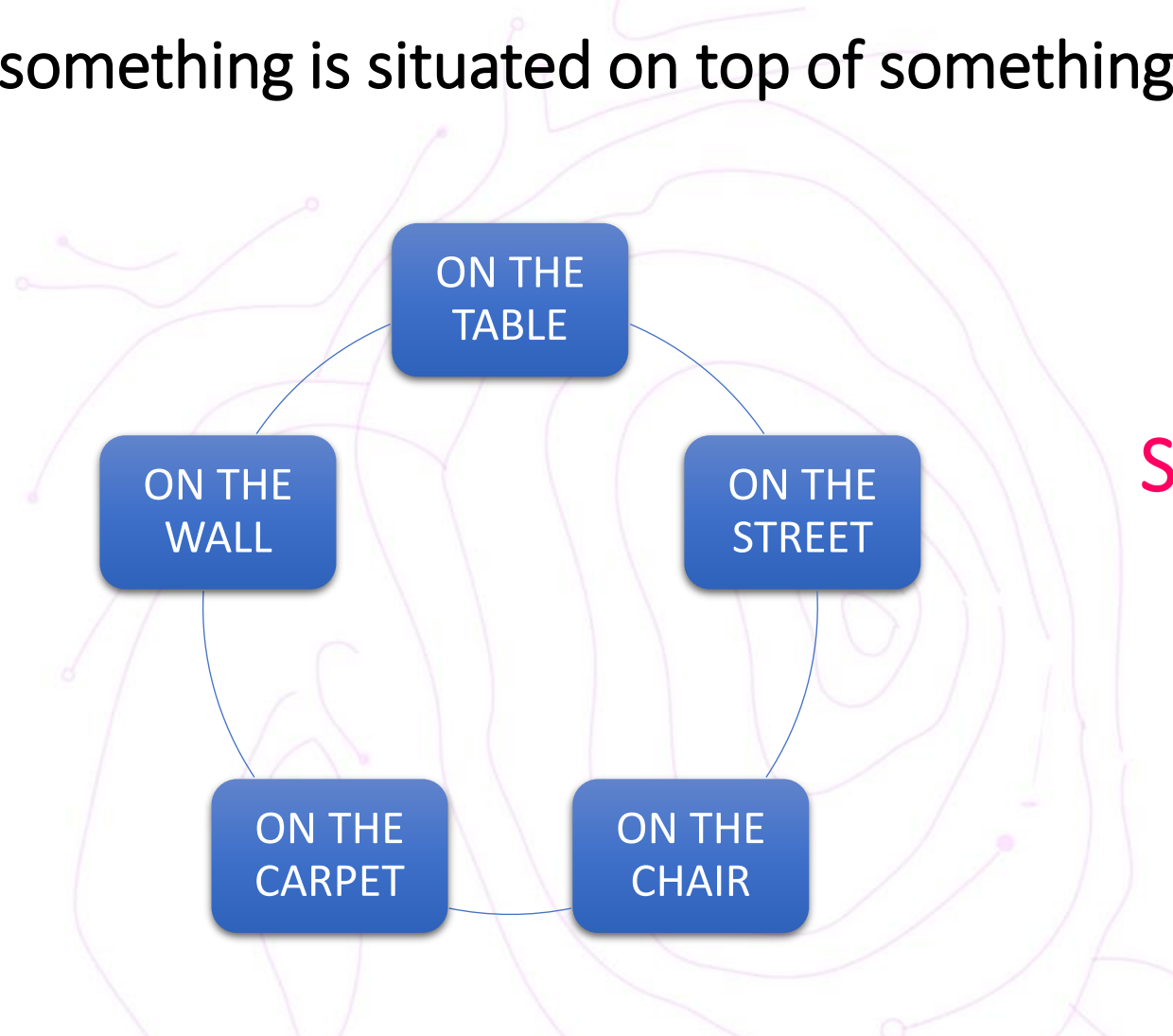
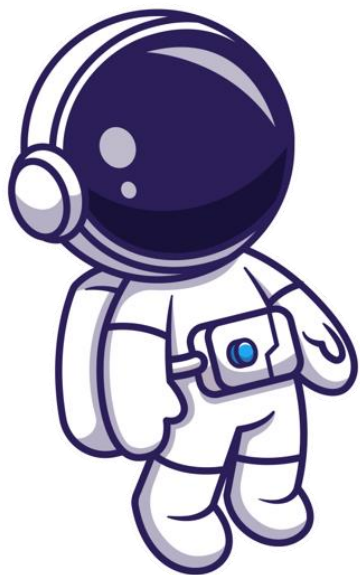
They found a lot of money **in his pocket**.





ON

Indicates that something is situated on top of something else.



SURFACES



EXAMPLE

The picture **on the wall** is fantastic.

You'll find more information about the camp **on this page**.

You should head to the theatre **on Second Street**.
