

Twitter: Elon Musk defends mass layoffs saying he had 'no choice'

Elon Musk, the **new owner of Twitter**, has defended laying off around half of the online platform's workforce, saying he had "no choice".

50% of Twitter employees were fired on Friday, according to Yoel Roth head of safety and integrity at the social media giant.

In a Tweet, Musk said "regarding Twitter's reduction in force, unfortunately there is no choice when the company is losing over \$4M/day."

Musk, the world's richest man, maintained that "Twitter's strong commitment to content moderation remains absolutely unchanged."

On Friday, Twitter Inc temporarily closed its offices after telling employees they will be informed by email later in the day whether they are being laid off.



Preposition	Links a noun to another word	At, in, of, on, after, under	She was hiding under the table.
Conjunction	Joins clauses or sentences	But, and while, when	I am very hungry, but the fridge is empty.
Interjection	Short exclamation	Oh!, hi!, ouch!, Wow!	Wow! What a beautiful car!

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
One syllable (sound): soft	Adjective + er: softer	The + adjective +est: the softest
One syllable ending e: nice	Adjective + r: nicer	The + adjective +st: the nicest
One syllable ending with a vowel + consonant: big	Adjective with last consonant doubled + er: bigger	The +adjective + doubled consonant + est: the biggest
Two syllables ending in y: funny	Adjective (y deleted) +ier: funnier	The adjective (y deleted) + iest: the funniest
Two or more syllables: colourful	More + adjective: more colourful	The most +adjective: the most colourful
Irregular: good, bad, far	Better, worse further/farther	The best, the worst, the furthest/farthest
