2) Before reading, explain what skimming strategy is.

Skimming is a reading strategy where you quickly glance through a text to get an overall sense of its content without necessarily reading every word or detail.







It involves looking at headings, subheadings, keywords, and the first and last sentences of paragraphs to grasp the main ideas. Skimming is useful for previewing material, determining the structure of a text, and deciding whether it's relevant to your specific needs or questions. It's a time-efficient way to assess the content and prioritize what to read more thoroughly.
