- Artificial Intelligence (AI). Meaning: the simulation of human intelligence in machines programmed to perform tasks that typically require human intelligence, such as visual perception, speech recognition, decision-making, and language translation. Machine Learning (ML).
- Meaning: a subset of AI that involves the development of algorithms allowing computers to learn patterns and make decisions based on data, without explicit programming. Neural Network.
 Meaning: a computerized model inspired by the human brain's structure and functioning, used in
- machine learning to recognize patterns and make decisions. Algorithm. Meaning: a step-by-step set of instructions or rules followed by a computer to perform a specific task or solve a particular
- problem. Natural Language Processing (NLP).
 Meaning: a branch of AI that focuses on the interaction between computers and humans using natural language, enabling machines to
- understand, interpret, and generate human language.











- **Deep Learning. Meaning:** a subset of machine learning that involves neural networks with multiple layers (deep neural networks), enabling the model to automatically learn hierarchical representations of data.
- Chatbot. Meaning: a computer program designed to simulate conversation with human users, especially over the Internet, providing information or assistance through text or voice interactions.
- **Computer Vision. Meaning:** a field of AI that enables machines to interpret and understand visual information from the world, including image recognition, object detection, and scene analysis.
- Big Data. Meaning: extremely large and complex datasets that cannot be effectively processed using traditional data processing methods, often requiring advanced AI and analytics tools.
- Ethical AI. Meaning: the practice of developing
 and using AI systems in a way that aligns with ethical principles, ensuring fairness, transparency, accountability, and the consideration of societal impacts.
