Web3:

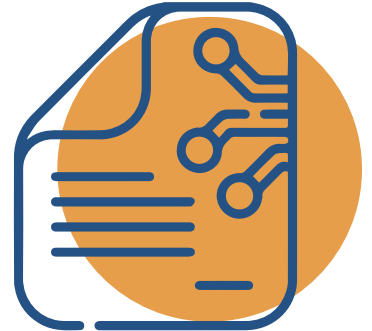
The next generation of the internet, characterized by decentralized applications and smart contracts.
