Cloud Economics	The total cost of owning and operating an asset or system over its entire lifecycle, including acquisition, operation, and maintenance costs.
Return on Investment (ROI)	The ability of cloud computing to provide access to computing resources from anywhere in the world, reducing the need for physical infrastructure and associated labor costs.
Total Cost of Ownership (TCO)	The study of cloud computing's costs and benefits, focusing on economic principles underlying them.
Economies of Scale	The expenses associated with transferring IT operations to the cloud or switching between cloud providers, including labor, integration, and testing costs.
Global Reach	A measure used to evaluate the financial gain or loss generated relative to the amount of money invested.
Business Agility	The process of comparing one's own practices, processes, or performance metrics to those of industry leaders or best practices, often used to assess the cost effectiveness of cloud adoption.
Benchmarking	The ability of a business to adapt quickly to changes in the market or customer demands, facilitated by cloud computing resources that allow for rapid deployment and scalability.
Migration Costs	The cost advantages that organizations achieve by scaling their operations and increasing production levels, resulting in lower average costs per unit.
